

**RESOLUTION NO. 23-R-2
RESOLUTION APPROVING AMENDMENT TO INTERGOVERNMENTAL
AGREEMENT FOR FIRE DEPARTMENT DISPATCH SERVICES WITH THE
VILLAGE OF ADDISON**

WHEREAS, the Pleasantview Fire Protection District, an Illinois municipal corporation, Cook and DuPage Counties, Illinois, entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement for Fire Department Dispatch Services with the Village of Addison, an Illinois municipal corporation, DuPage County, Illinois in 2016, which has been amended; and

WHEREAS, the Pleasantview Fire Protection District and the Village of Addison wish to modify and extend that Intergovernmental Agreement pursuant to the terms set forth on the attached Exhibit G.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Pleasantview Fire Protection District, an Illinois municipal corporation, Cook and DuPage Counties, Illinois, that the 2016 Intergovernmental Agreement for Fire Department Dispatch Services with the Village of Addison, an Illinois municipal corporation, DuPage County, Illinois, is hereby modified and extended pursuant to the terms and provisions set forth on the attached Exhibit G, which are incorporated herein by reference; and

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the remaining provisions of the said Intergovernmental Agreement with the Village of Addison are reaffirmed, as modified; and



EXHIBIT G – PLEASANTVIEW FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT

G-1. Pleasantview Customer Services

Addison shall provide personalized services to Pleasantview including answering in person telephone calls from Pleasantview personnel. Addison shall provide notifications to Public Works, Public Utilities, Hospitals, and other agencies during emergency responses. Addison will contact the appropriate District personnel of any emergency by phone, radio, alpha numeric paging or other agreed upon methods, following mutually agreed upon procedures. Pleasantview will answer any non-emergency/administrative phone lines and these phone lines will not be automatically transferred to Addison. Addison is not responsible for responding to any non-emergency/administrative phone lines.

G-2. Pleasantview Equipment

Pleasantview shall be responsible for procuring and maintaining, at its own cost, its mobile and portable radio equipment and repeaters for use by its personnel using the system, and any required enhancements shall be at Pleasantview's cost. Addison may, after mutual agreement, choose to use equipment currently installed in the Pleasantview Fire Stations. Pleasantview will be credited toward future services fees, as outlined in Section G-3, an amount agreed to in writing, if applicable. Any equipment not used by Addison may be retained or disposed of by Pleasantview.

G-3. Pleasantview Services Fee


For the period of May 1, 2023 through April 30, 2024, the Pleasantview Fire Protection District shall pay an Annual Service Fee to ACDC in the amount of \$282,277.00. For the period of May 1, 2024 through April 30, 2025, the Pleasantview Fire Protection District shall pay an Annual Service Fee to ACDC in the amount of \$282,277.00 with payment scheduled according to the provisions of Paragraph 11 herein.

G-4. MABAS Dispatching

ACDC agrees to work to maintain the ability to dispatch MABAS Alarms and offer those

services to the MABAS Division of which Pleasantview is a member. If the offer to dispatch MABAS alarms is accepted, ACDC may recover reasonable costs exclusive to MABAS dispatching, as agreed to, from the applicable MABAS Division.
